Adolf Hansen notes that, "In the original language of Matthew 28:19—the verse in which Jesus says "Go and make disciples of all nations"—the verb matheteuo simply means to disciple. The word make is not in the Greek text. Therefore, that book uses the words "to lead others to become disciples" rather than "make disciples"—a rewording offered to The UMC for consideration."ⁱ
