### A Better Life – Brianna’s Hope

The opioid crisis and other addictions have devastated too many communities and families in our state. A Better Life – Brianna’s Hope (ABL-BH) is a recovery ministry that has been growing and has a history of partnership with many United Methodist Churches in the Indiana Conference. Brianna’s Hope is “participant-driven, faith-based, and compassion-filled”, and it is our privilege to support this ministry at our 2019 Annual Conference.

**Riverside’s Close Knit Friends** donated two prayer shawls which will be given to new ABL-BH participants at their first meeting as a powerful reminder that God and the community is always available for them. The over 1,200 lap blankets and prayer shawls collected at annual conference will be distributed to the more than 30 ABL-BH chapters.
